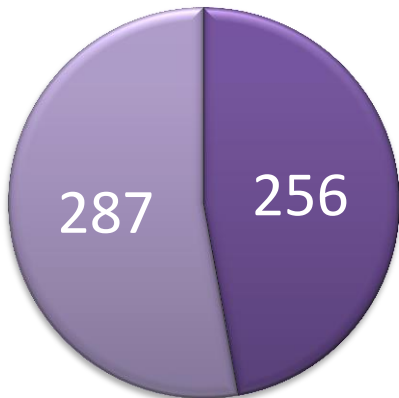


The Voluntary & Community Sector in North Tyneside 2015-16

The Sector consists of more than 540 charities, groups, clubs and other organisations.

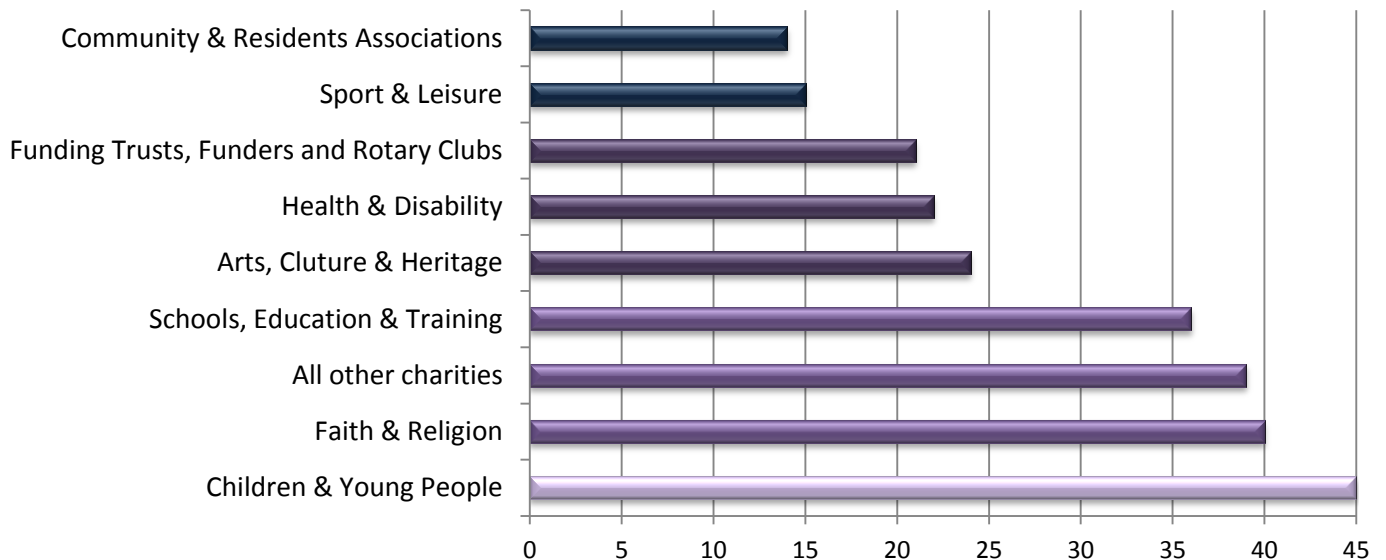
Nearly all non-charity groups and clubs have incomes of less than £10,000.

The Percy Hedley Foundation is the only major charity based in North Tyneside. It accounts for 48% of all charitable income.

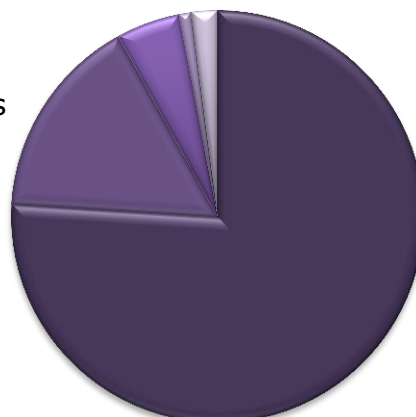

The Most Numerous Charities



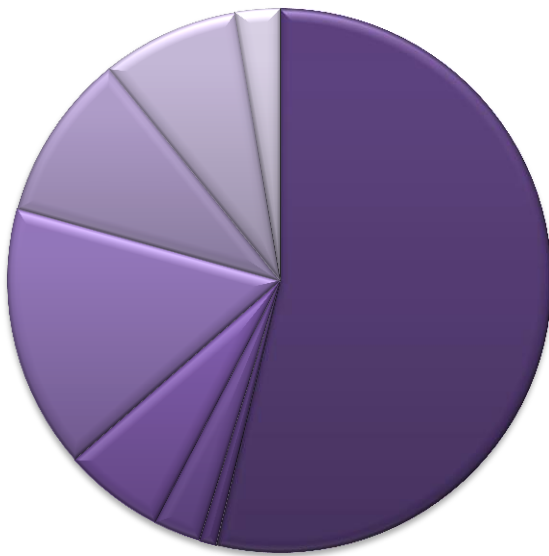
More than three-quarters of those charities which are based in in North Tyneside operate within the borough.

A further 16% work sub-regionally with 5% operating regionally, about 2% internationally and just 1% nationally

The monetary value* of volunteers is between **£25.1m** and **£29.7m**

The Total Value of North Tyneside's Charities

The value of North Tyneside's charities is estimated at between **£73.5** and **£78.1 million**. This is the value of volunteering plus the total income. Assets are not included, e.g. property. Charities therefore enrich the borough's residents by between **£363** and **£386** per person (based on a population of 202,494).

Beneficiaries

National research indicates that beneficiaries access, on average, 2.4 charities each.
