

## Safeguarding Training for Voluntary Organisations in North Tyneside

All paid staff and volunteers need to be aware of their responsibilities for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and adults at risk of abuse and neglect. They should know how to respond to concerns and how to make referrals if necessary. The North Tyneside Safeguarding Children Board (NTSCB) and Safeguarding Adult Board (SAB) provide a range of training to meet this need, which is free to small voluntary organisations, and open to anyone who works or volunteers with children, young people, families and adults at risk, in North Tyneside.

### How can I access the training?

North Tyneside Council hosts an online booking system for both NTSCB and SAB training. To set up a free account go to <http://northtyneside.learningpool.com> and click 'new user'. ### Which training should I do?

Choose a training option which best suits your role, depending on if you work with children, or adults, or both. Check this out with your organisation too.
