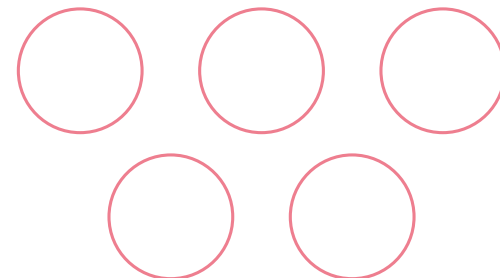


The Great Community Garden Crawl is a collaborative effort between the Grow & Eat project and five garden members of the Garden Network of North Tyneside.

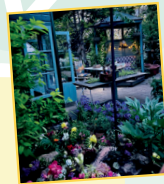
